


# **Emergency Projects in the Philippines**

# Typhoon Haiyan/Yolanda



- Entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility on 8 November 2013
- Most affected: Eastern Samar, Leyte, Northern Cebu, Panay Island, and Palawan



- 3,424,593 families or 16,078,181 individuals affected (890,895 families or 4,095,280 individuals displaced)
- 1,084,762 houses damaged (partially damaged are 595,149 and totally damaged are 489,613).
- Total damage is estimated to total PhP 89.6 billion (or EUR 1.5 billion)




**6,300 people died (National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Committee, 17 April 2014)**

- Relief and Rebuilding of Typhoon Yolanda affected communities in San Jose, Tacloban City
  - Transportation of medical and relief supplies
  - Relief assistance and home and community reconstruction materials
  - Psychosocial care and community spaces for children
  - Livelihood support
  - Community-based disaster risk reduction and preparation mechanisms

- Project partner: Medical Action Group
- Humanitarian Support for the Typhoon Yolanda survivors in the Islands of Eastern Samar
- Interventions:
  - Medical missions
  - Relief assistance
  - Psychosocial care and child-friendly spaces project debriefing for staff
- Status: completed



# MAGEmergency2-Phil-13

- Project partner: Medical Action Group
- Emergency and Relief Assistance to survivors of Typhoon Yolanda in Hamorawon and Banaag, Manicani Island
- 10.500 from the Lower Saxony State Chancellery and 500 from tdh HUIH funds
- Provision of relief assistance and transport to 2 out of the 4 focus villages in the island of Manicani (provision of food and non-food items)
- Status: completed

# FTCEmergency-Phil-13

- Project partner: Feed the Children
- Interventions:
  - Setting up of feeding stations and training of 3 team members of local implementing partners for actual conduct of feeding activities.
- Status: Extended until  
15 July 2014





## GAIAEmergency-Phil-14

- Project partner: Global Alliance for Incinerator Alternatives (GAIA)
- Interventions:
  - Repair of damaged houses
  - Livelihood provision
  - Planning for disaster preparedness;
  - Participatory assessment of its waste management system
  - Setting up of materials recovery facility.

Status: ongoing



## tdhNLEmergency-Phil-14

- Partner : terre des Hommes Netherlands  
Philippine Country Office
- Interventions:
  - Repair of damaged houses
  - Repair of class rooms

Status: completed



## BuilderEmergency-Phil-14

- Partner: Broad and Unified Initiatives for Life's Development and Environmental Restoration (BUILDER), Incorporated
- Interventions:
  - Mangrove reforestation
  - Setting up of disaster risk mapping and planning
  - Organizing of children and people's organizations on the issue of ecology protection and disaster risk reduction and preparation

Status: ongoing



# BuligVisayas-Phil-14

- Partner: Bulig Visayas
- Interventions:
  - Policy advocacy: promotion of meaningful participation in the formulation of rehabilitation plans and engagement with government on early recovery and rehabilitation.
  - Project Pag-aram: school supplies for students and teachers

Status: ongoing
